

From Anchorage: 238 miles north on the Parks Highway, around 5 hours travel time.

From Wasilla:

194 miles north on the Parks Highway, around 4 hours travel time.

From Talkeetna:

152 miles north on the Parks Highway, around 3 hours travel time.

From Fairbanks: 110 miles south on the Parks Highway, around 2 hours travel time.

Our Tour Office is located on the Denali Rainbow Village Boardwalk Mall at Mile 238.6 Parks Hwy, 1/2 mile north of the Denali National Park entrance & across the highway from the Denali Princess Lodge.



A majority of the Denali area is only open May-September & closed the rest of the year. Healy, the closest town to Denali, has year-round motels, restaurants & services.

Although Denali National Park will have limited access in the winter, you can still visit to view the Northern Lights & experience -40° F cold!





Tour Details & Policies

-Tours are not in Denali National Park. From the George Parks Highway, the Denali Highway runs east along the Alaska Range & the Park Road runs west along the same range.
-Restroom stops are available during the tour.
-Tours depart & continue rain or shine. Tour covers 100+ miles & spans several microclimates. Weather changes unexpectedly.
-Views of Denali & glaciers are weather dependent.
-Remember that wildlife is WILD. Our guides are experienced spotters but we can't guarantee any wildlife sightings.
-The Denali Highway is a public road & loosely maintained by the State of Alaska. All driving laws must be followed.
-All Drivers must be at least 25 years of age & provide a valid

driver's license. The option to ride with the guide may be available, upon request.

-All drivers & passengers must agree to & sign a Participation Agreement prior to tour departure.

-Seats are sold on a per seat basis & may result in parties of 1 sharing a Jeep with another party of 1.

-Car seats & booster seats are available for small children. -This tour may not be suitable for young children. -Cancellation policy: Your reservation must be cancelled 48

hours prior to your tour time to receive a refund.





New, 4-door Jeeps hug the dirt road, while comfortably seating four adults who can trade off driving. Each Jeep has a CB radio for communicating with the guide so stops can be made whenever desired.

As driving the Denali Highway is prohibited by most rental vehicle companies, this exclusive excursion provides access to more of Alaska's spectacular scenery and wildlife & is a great alternative to crowded bus trips. Snacks & drinks provided.
